Fire Safety and Awareness Tips:

- Purchase an ABC type extinguisher for putting out all types of fires.
 Fire extinguishers should be mounted in the kitchen, garage, and workshop to put out small fires. If there is a large fire, get out immediately and call 911 or your local emergency number.
- When lighting a gas fireplace or gas space heater, strike your match first and then turn on the gas.
- Because fire is a risk in every building whether you sleep, study, or work there you should always have an escape plan. You may need to escape within a few minutes of when a fire starts, so your safe exit depends on immediate warning from smoke alarms and advance planning of escape routes

If you do decide to disconnect your landline H&S can keep your system working by making it a cell back-up system and your system will still be functional by sending signals through your cell phone.
